

An Important Recall:
August 2, 2007

Fisher-Price, in cooperation with the CPSC, is recalling about 967,000 children's toys. The recall involves Dora the Explorer, Sesame Street and other figures and toys that were manufactured between April 19, 2007 and July 6, 2007 and were sold alone or as part of sets. The recalled toys are all marked with "Fisher-Price." You can find a more detailed listing of the specific recalled toys, including model names and product numbers at www.cpsc.gov. Surface paints on these recalled toys contain lead. Lead is toxic if ingested by young children and can cause adverse health effects.
